worship

- Introducing new worship songs and settings for the mass and other liturgical celebrations ✓
- the installation of multimedia equipment to project hymns and songs, texts etc for all to read easily ; developing the use of the Sunday Bulletin as a missionary / evangelistic / teaching tool ✓
- Creating much needed space for use by parents / carers and their toddlers (a Crèche) within the church ✓ (in progress)
- Developing our ministry amongst the youngsters who worship with us – setting aside one mass a month for them to have more say in by planning music, helping in various ministries etc ✓
- Developing our ministry of Welcome ✓

stewardship

- Building on the successful work of past campaigns – particularly with regard to raising the awareness of the people of God of the need to give freely and encouraging the use of giving by Gift Aid ✓

halls

- Bringing the halls up to a high standard for use by the community by applying for a lottery grant for refurbishment / renewal ✓

publicity

- Providing a new notice board on the Bounds Green Road side of the church ✓
- Developing and revising the Sunday Bulletin further as a missionary tool ✓
